Taking Communion

In February 2004, I heard God say, "take communion every day." At the time, I thought it was because of a physical issue, but as time went on, God showed me that He was healing me from the inside out through the power of daily communion. The Bible says that healing is the children's bread (Mark 7:27) and I want to take this time to share with you about the power that is released on your behalf, when you understand about the 3-fold covenant

Isaiah 53:3-5 says, "He is despised and rejected by men, a man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him. Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgression, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed." 1 Thessalonians 5:23 tells us that we are a 3 part being. God declared that we be sanctified wholly spirit, soul and body. When we partake of communion, we bring into remembrance the complete redemptive work at Calvary.

Bent, But Not Broken! A true testimony!

Psalm 46:1 & 10 (KJV) : God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Be still, and know that I *am* God: I will exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth.

In September 2007, I was laid off from a position as an Environmental Health and Safety Manager of a company where I was responsible for administrating and managing environmental and safety matters for a company of 100 employees located in two states. For the next year and a half, I worked part-time and contractual as an environmental consultant and community college teacher. The consultant and teacher work significantly reduced my income and carried no health or retirement benefits; thereby leaving me underemployed (and at times) unemployed! I also experienced significant hardships including mental and physical illness, and ultimately, repossession and foreclosure. It was the most humbling experience of my life as I received grace and mercy from various family and friends (to include the servants, supporters and work of Wilson Ministries) with moral and financial support. I also began selling all my possessions just to maintain!

These hardships really challenged my faith and penetrated my soul to the fullest as I sought diligently for God's will, and what is the Holy Spirit manifesting within me? My experiences and hardships during this time of unemployment and underemployment taught me many valuable lessons, sharpened my skills and abilities, and increased my awareness and knowledge. These are the things I have learned:

God is the only constant certainty for everything.

To use the power of networking and using my God-given talents and gifts to increase my passion (territory).

That pursuing higher education is required to give excellence in service, for to whom much is given, much is required!

Financial stewardship – You are being blessed to be a blessing to others! I also learned and experienced firsthand that financial management impacts your retirement and credit.

That God will restore you. You have to be placed on the Potter's Wheel to be restored and refined to come forth as pure gold.

God's greatest desire or purpose is our surrendering to HIS will and serving him with great praise. He is worthy to be praised, for when the praises go up, the blessings really do come down!

God is no respecter of persons! What he has for you is for you.

In March, 2009, God blessed me by taking me to another level - the High Places of His Will (My Destiny). I am now employed again as a Corporate Environmental Health and Safety Manager, administrating environmental safety and health for 3000+ employees over 27 states. I also received a substantial pay raise over my previous position. God is faithful and just to equip you will all that you need for your journey. He is and will give to you abundantly (more and above) what you can ask or even mentally conceive!

For I was hungry and you gave Me food, I was thirsty and you gave Me something to drink, I was a stranger and you brought Me together with yourselves and welcomed and entertained and lodged Me, I was naked and you clothed Me, I was sick and you visited Me with help and ministering care, I was in prison and you came to see Me. Then the just and upright will answer Him, Lord, when did we see you hungry and gave you food, or thirsty and gave You something to drink? And when did we see you a stranger and welcomed and entertained You, or naked and clothed You? And when did we see You sick or in prison and came to visit You? And the King will reply to them, Truly I tell you, in so far as you did it for one of the least in the estimation of men] of these My brethren, you did it for Me.”

Every month Wilson Ministries goes to Washington, D.C. to provide food, toiletries, clothing and hope through the Gospel of Jesus Christ to a portion of the Homeless community. We listen to and share with these individuals who have found themselves in this situation, without a home (other than on the streets) or the hope that Christ will help them. Additionally, we attempt to provide anything we can to address their needs; from those such as a man who only needed a stamp to mail in his application to get on the housing list (he had one, but it rained the night before...think about it), to the man who lost his son, checked out of life and longed to hear a hymn like he did at his grandmother's church. From the woman who just needed a bus pass to get to her computer class so she could get a job, to the one who had size 10 feet so the shoes that were often donated were too small.

Yes, Wilson Ministries takes pride in helping to provide a small glimpse of Christ to these individuals who have lost all. We are a blessed people and God has commanded us to go to these and share the HIS love!

Communion (con't)

Our atonement was broken down in 3 parts. (1) Jesus was wounded for our transgressions and bruised for iniquities which purchased our spiritual atonement. (2) Chastisement of our peace that was upon Him purchased our mental/emotional atonement and (3) by his stripes we were healed purchased our physical atonement. The covenant we have with God was not just one of salvation, but it is a covenant of complete wholeness.

Exodus 12:7-14... *“And they shall take of the blood, and strike it on the two side posts and on the upper door post of the houses, wherein they shall eat it. And they shall eat the flesh in that night...”* The instruction was to eat the flesh and put the blood over the door post. The blood represented the protection/deliverance power of God and because they ate the flesh of the lamb, the Bible said as they exodus out of Egypt, there was not one feeble person among them. (Psalms 105:37) That was a type and shadow of what was to come, because Jesus said that He is the spotless Lamb that took away the sin of the world and that we have redemption through the shedding of His blood.

Jesus said that He is the Bread of Life and he that eats of Him shall never hunger. (John 6) So when we partake of communion we remember all that Jesus did on our behalf at Calvary. The Bible says that the very thing that is against us and that was contrary to us, He took it out of the way by nailing it to the cross. (Col 2:14) What that means is whether it is cancer, lupus, heart condition, diabetes, asthma, arthritis, low self-esteem, poverty, rejection or whatever aileth thee à Jesus said, He nailed it to the cross and then made an open show to the devil that it has no authority or right to dwell in your body.

1 Corinthians 11: 24-31 ... *“take, eat, this is my body, which is broken for you; this do in remembrance of me. After that same manner also he took the cup when he had supped, saying, this cup is the new testament in the blood; this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me. For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do show the Lord’s death til he comes. Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread and drink this cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord. But let a man examine himself and so let him eat of that bread and drink of that cup. For he that eat and drink unworthily, eat and drink damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord’s body. For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep. For if we would judge ourselves, we should not be judged.*

Matthew 8:17... *“Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses.”*

The benefits in taking communion daily is that we (1) continually purify our hearts, which in turns brings us into a closer walk with God; (2) keep the power of the enemy limited; (3) preventative medicine for our body and soul; (4) continually examine where we are, judging ourselves; (5) continually remind God of our covenant with Him; and (6) continually remind ourselves what Jesus did for us on the cross.

In short, you take a cracker and juice; sanctify it for the purpose of communion. Ask God to search your heart to see there is anything that is not pleasing to Him, release it over to God, ask for forgiveness and then partake of communion. Make a demand on your covenant to be free from the power of the enemy (be specific—call out its name—ex: anger, bitterness, sickness, pain, diseases, unforgiveness, rejection, resentment, etc.) Release the resurrection power of Christ to work in your life. You must resist the attacks of the enemy (thoughts of defeat, pain, sickness, etc.) and pursue healing and wholeness. We appropriate the power in communion by confessing with our mouths and believing in our hearts. It's not magic, the cracker & juice isn't Jesus, it represents a spiritual principle and when we release our faith in communion then we will begin to experience all the benefits and the power of God flowing in every area of our lives.

Communion (con't)

It is God's desire and will for you to be healed from every past hurt, unresolved issue and/or unmet need in your life. It is through communion that you allow God to go into the secret places in your soul to uncover the things that lie dormant and bring about wholeness so you can begin to walk into the fullness of your destiny.

For all who think that only a priest or ordained minister can minister communion and if you think it can only take place in church, the following scriptures are for you:

Luke 24:30-31... *"And it came to pass, as he sat at meat with them, he took bread and blessed it and brake and gave to them. And their eyes were opened, and they knew him..."* Acts 2:46... *"And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart."* The disciples daily broke bread together and I submit to you that this wasn't just eating a regular meal, but they were partaking in covenant (communion) being with singleness of heart. Daily God rained down manna from heaven and Jesus tells us that He is the bread of the new and everlasting covenant and as often as you do this, do it in remembrance of me.

1 Pet 2:9... *"But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation a peculiar people..."* Rev 1:6... *"And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father..."* If you have confess Jesus as Lord and you are born again, God says that the Body of Christ is a kingdom of priests and we are to minister unto our God the sacrifices of praise, thanksgiving, worship, obedience and communion daily.

Salvation is more than just going to heaven. The Greek word is "sozo" which means to be delivered, made whole, completeness, healed, soundness of mind. Your covenant relationship with God is that you be complete, healed and made whole in every area of your life. You must make a demand on your covenant and pursue wholeness with God. Not putting up with ANYTHING that you think you have to deal with the rest of your life. The Bible says that the Kingdom of God suffers violence but the violent takes it by force. Be diligent and persistent and when you continue in the Word, then you'll know the truth and the truth is what will make you free from every lie of the devil. (John 8:31).
